SINGLE ALLOWANCE: MAKE IT TRULY UNIVERSAL

The introduction of the Single and Universal Allowance was a fundamental choice. Critical issues and exclusions remain and must be addressed as soon as possible.

Europe is also asking us to remove, as soon as possible, the critical issues that penalise many families, starting with workers who do not have access to the Single and Universal Allowance because they have not resided in Italy for at least two years or whose children do not reside in Italy or who do not have a work contract of at least six months.

Some examples:

- A worker with a spouse and two children aged 10 and 12 living abroad, who had an income of €25,300 per year in 2020, lost deductions and the family allowance of € 282.83 per month, or € 3,393.96 per year with the changeover to the Single Allowance.
- A widowed worker with two children aged 8 and 11 living abroad and a domestic work income of €14,800 lost € 394.25 per month, or € 4,731.00 per year.
- The loss for a worker with a spouse and three children aged 2, 6 and 10 years living abroad, and an earned income of EUR 30,200, is € 446.46 per month, or € 5,357.52 per year.
